Format for the 45 minute presentations by each of the six current CORRT Scholars:

These presentations can take one of two formats:

Format #1 is for Scholars that have already submitted a grant and have received feedback from the review panel.

The scholar will spend 15-20 minutes presenting:

- an overview of the proposal (brief introduction and outline of the specific aims),
- an outline of the reviewers' major comments, and
- an anticipated response to the reviewers' comments and possible modifications to the project.
- Introduction to poster (less than 5 minutes) within your 30 minute presentation.

-or-

Format #2 is for scholars that have either not yet submitted a grant, have submitted a grant but have not yet received any feedback from the review panel, or submitted a grant that was funded.

The scholar will spend 15-20 minutes presenting:

- an overview of a planned or submitted proposal (brief presentation of the background, specific aims, and design),
- areas of concerns or areas for which feedback is needed and
- for submitted grants that were funded, a discussion of what the scholar believes was the key components of success.
- Introduction to poster (less than 5 minutes) within your 15-20 minute presentation.

Format #1 and #2, the remaining 25-30 minutes will be used for discussion and feedback from the group.
